

Attendance Matters


100% Week 4 Attendance – congratulations to Aiden and Audrey!




Harrington's Got Talent

- Drawing equal groups











Yellow Room

- Showing Teacher appreciation using Minecraft where we built a classroom with tech room and aquarium. By Declan and Jack M








Blue Room


